ORDER FOR FITNESS TO PROCEED EVALUATION
TEXAS FAMILY CODE SEC. 51.20, 55.31

Having considered the Motion for a Fitness to Proceed Examination, by

- The Court, on its own motion,
- The State of Texas by and through an Assistant Fort Bend County District Attorney,
- The Attorney for the Defendant,

The Court FINDS that sufficient evidence exists to suggest that the Juvenile may be unfit to proceed in juvenile court. Accordingly, the Court appoints:

Dr. M. Connie Almeida, or another licensed psychologist employed by or contracted with **Fort Bend County Behavioral Health Services, (281)-238-3079**, who, pursuant to the Texas Family Code Sec. 51.20, meets Tex. Code Crim. Proc. Art. 46B.022 criteria, to examine the defendant and to file a written report with the court in accordance with Chapter 46B, of the code of criminal procedure, considering the factors listed in Tex. Code Crim. Proc. Art. 46B.024/.025, and other issues he or she determines relevant. **This court order is to be faxed to BHS Court Orders at 281-238-3250 or emailed to BHSCourtOrders@fortbendcountytexas.gov.**

The Court temporarily stays the juvenile court proceedings and **Orders** the Juvenile be examined pursuant to Texas Family Code 51.20 and 55.31. The Court further **Orders** that the examiner in this case prepare a written report and submit it to this Court within thirty (30) days of the date of this order.

In addition, the Court **Orders** the counsel for the State and Juvenile provide Fort Bend County Behavioral Health Services with any school or medical records for the Juvenile in their possession.
