FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – April 2018

From April 1, 2018 to April 30, 2018, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 84%. The save rate for dogs was 96% and for cats it was 67%. Last month 34 feral cats were euthanized as per the current policies and procedures.

The save rate does not include 13 dogs that were owner requested euthanasia for the entire month of April 2018.

Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
